Nursing students need to have access to health information from an authoritative source. The Palm Beach County Library System website, [www.pbclibrary.org](http://www.pbclibrary.org) gives you access to health information at your fingertips. The Library's health databases let you research a condition, alternative therapy, medical terms, and much more right from your home, office, or library branch. Electronic databases are easy-to-use, and from reliable publishers. The databases allow you to read, print, and email complete articles with a library card or TRAC (Temporary Research Access Code).

CINAHL® with Full Text is the world's most comprehensive nursing and allied health research database providing full-text for more than 610 nursing and allied health journals (and indexing for an additional 3,000 journals), as well as health care books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, and more (with coverage dating back to 1981).

If you are studying for the NCLEX or another exam, check out LearningExpress, which contains online learning with skill building modules, test preparation materials and practice exams, including test preparation eBooks.

Health and Wellness Resource Center and Alternative Health Module has trusted medical reference materials from encyclopedias and dictionaries, directories, magazines, journals, pamphlets, and newspapers, in addition to a broad collection of Gale health reference titles. You will find complete articles in English and Spanish on current health news and research, diseases and conditions, herbal remedies, local support information, and much more.
